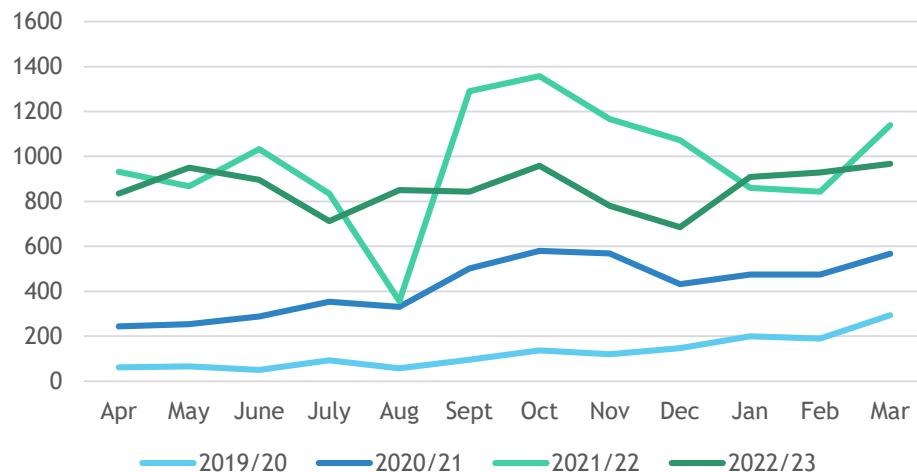

Referrals into LSH - Psychosexual Therapy

We are currently offering service users sessions via video, telephone and face-to-face.

We accept referrals for:

- ▶ Female orgasmic disorder.
- ▶ Female sexual interest/arousal disorder.
- ▶ Genito-pelvic pain/penetration disorder (i.e. vaginismus, dyspareunia).
- ▶ Ejaculatory problems - delayed or premature.
- ▶ Erectile dysfunction.
- ▶ Male hypoactive sexual desire disorder.

Not commissioned to offer for:

- ▶ Gender reassignment
- ▶ Sex and porn addiction
- ▶ Trauma therapy

Referrals must be made through PRISM

Referrals into LSH - Complex Contraception

Our service accepts referrals for women with complex contraception needs.

We accept referrals for:

- ▶ Contraception choice complicated by co-morbidity
- ▶ Difficult IUC fitting where method is used for contraception
- ▶ Difficult IUC removal (non-visible or avulsed threads)
- ▶ Removal of implants that are not palpable/have no pop-up sign
- ▶ Removal of implant where previous failed removal attempt
- ▶ Removal of unusual implants (Jadelle or Norplant)

Referrals must be made through PRISM

Other referrals into LSH

Our service also accepts referrals for:

- ▶ Those patients who require **complex GU care**
- ▶ Those patients requiring an **IUS for non-contraceptive purposes**
 - ▶ This includes for menorrhagia and HRT

Referrals must be made through PRISM

- ▶ Patients who are vulnerable requiring contraception or a sexual health consultation (e.g. with a learning disability or a young person at risk of CSE) and would benefit from a specialist consultation - we have a dedicated referral pathway. Please use the form available on our website.

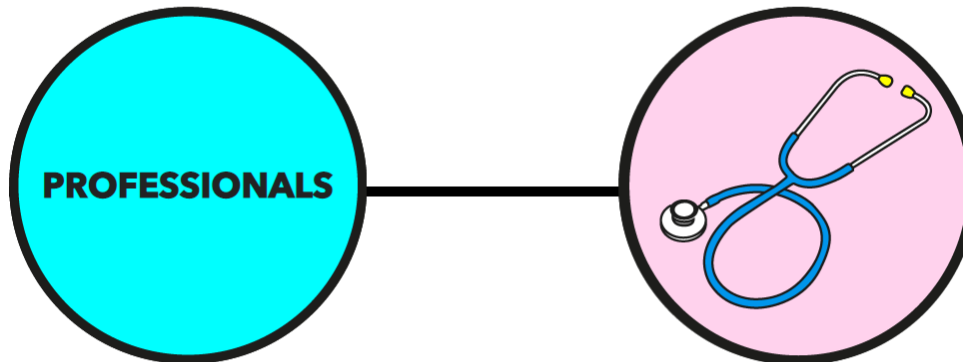
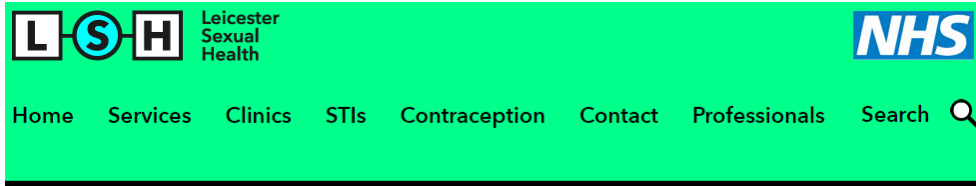
